



Chinook Gate HOA Policy: Political Campaigning at Chinook Gate HOA Events

Purpose:

To maintain a neutral and inclusive environment at all Chinook Gate HOA events, this policy outlines the guidelines regarding political campaigning and the presence of elected officials.

Policy Statement:

Campaigning for political positions, directly, indirectly, or by proxy, is **not permitted** at any Chinook Gate HOA-sponsored events. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Distribution of campaign materials (e.g., flyers, buttons, signs)
- Solicitation of votes or political support
- Speeches or announcements promoting a political candidacy or party

Attendance of Elected Officials:

Elected officials are **welcome to attend** HOA events in a non-campaigning capacity. Their presence is encouraged when it contributes to community engagement, awareness, or support for local initiatives.

Enforcement:

HOA Board Members and event organizers are responsible for monitoring compliance with this policy. Individuals who violate the policy will be asked to cease campaigning activities and will be asked to leave the event if they do not comply.
